The country's largest population of indigenous live in the Otavalo region so we thought that's where we'd begin, but through fervent prayer and guidance from the Holy Spirit as well as input of field experience, we see our future home and a large part of our ministry among those that live in the Pastocalle region. Still working with the indigenous but with those that have been separated among their people...truly the least and the last *among* the least and the last. Our hearts have always been heavy for the least of God's people and we have been given the awesome privilege to minister among them. We feel truly blessed and know in our hearts that He is leading us to the people He has chosen for us...where the gifts and talents He's given us can best draw others unto Him and where God can best be glorified. "...which God prepared in advance for us to do." Eph 2:10 We are so excited and humbled at the direction God is leading us and praise Him everyday for those who fervently pray and financially support the ministry God has asked of us.
